THEATRE GUIDELINES

The Theatre has certain guidelines for use of the Stage. These have been designed for your benefit and to ensure the efficient running of your show.

- All tape tape and/or markings used on the Stage floor and walls should be removed at the end of each season/production.
- Painting of set or props is not permitted on the wooden Stage surface, except where suitable protection is in place.
- All fly battens must be correctly weighed at all times.
- Any damage to equipment or fittings will be at the expense of the Hirer.
- Any change in colour to the Stage surface will be at the expense of the Hirer including restoration to the original flat matt black colour.
- All sets, props, costumes and equipment belonging to the Hirer must be removed from the Theatre at the end of the last performance of the season unless otherwise arranged with the Theatre Technician or Theatre Management.
- Aisles, passageways and exit doors must not be obstructed in any way.
- All Stage cabling must be fastened down with gaffer tape where there are access paths. Cabling across exits and aisles must be covered with carpet or matts and secured with gaffer tape. In no way should they be a hazard to patrons, performers or staff.
- The flying of scenery and set pieces, the loading and unloading of counterweighted cradles must only be done by an approved flyman or under instruction by the Theatre Technician. All cradle counterweights to remain on fly floor gallery unless otherwise instructed by Theatre Technician.
- No Front of House lamp adjustment is permitted whilst audience is in the auditorium.
- Suitable protective clothing and footwear should be worn at all times. No bare feet, sandals or thongs.
- In the event of any accident, minor injury or other occurrence to Stage crew or performers, the Theatre Technician is to be notified of the nature of the injury or occurrence, what first aid was given and report what steps were taken to prevent repetition of such injury or occurrence.
- Please note that the Theatre Technicians' decisions regarding the use of the Stage, Control Room, Auditorium, Foyer and Venue Equipment are regarded as being those of the Manager.
- Please assist us to prevent accidents by using safe workplace practices at all times.
